We thoroughly enjoyed the conference and the Awards Banquet. It was a whirlwind of Southern hospitality, rich storytelling, literary insight, and remarkable people.

EATON FIRE RECOVERY OCTOBER 4 - 11, 2026

The Retired Clergy Association is planning its next mission work project for this fall in ALTADENA CA (near Pasadena), site of the devastating January 2025 LA fire which destroyed 9000 homes and in which 19 people lost their lives.

Recovery efforts are fully underway and volunteer teams have already been at work repairing damaged homes and rebuilding new ones, including two Volunteers in Mission teams from First UMC Santa Rosa. We will be partnering with Hope Crisis Response Network, a faith-based non-profit organization serving communities impacted by disasters since 1999. RCA has worked with HCRN rebuilding homes in Lower Lake and Paradise following destructive fires in those communities and looks forward to working with HCRN again in Altadena.

Sunday October 4 thru Friday Oct 11, 2026, is the date for RCA's work team. Skilled and non-skilled participants are needed and welcome! There is no cost to participate except for transportation. RCA is planning to rent a large van for interested team members or folks may prefer to fly or drive their own cars.

Deadline to REGISTER is **AUGUST 15th** and registration will be limited to 15 persons. If you are interested please RSVP soon, even if you may not be fully committed at this time. This will help the planning team as we move forward.
